The Analytical Approach to Law

- ***Can an analytical approach to law provide predictable outcomes?***
 - ***A larger number of documents (Court Orders/Opinions) are becoming available in electronic, searchable format.***
 - ***Legal think tanks and lawyers are trying to use this data to find patterns and trends.***
 - ***Can you predict an outcome based on similar variables in a jurisdiction or before a specific judge?***



How Docketing Plays a Part

- ***Docketing departments have unique access to a firm's legal experience.***
 - ***Calendaring matters and deadlines in a consistent manner can create an easily searchable database.***
 - ***Business Development departments can obtain detailed overview of experience to potential clients.***
 - ***Tracking outcomes and other key data can help firm leaders gauge practice groups effectiveness.***



Using Excel to Provide Analytical Reports

- ***How can Excel assist in providing analytical reports?***
 - ***A pivot table is a tool that allows you to quickly summarize and analyze large amounts of data in your Excel spreadsheet.***
 - ***Docketing professionals can use this type of report to drill down on large, complex data sets.***
