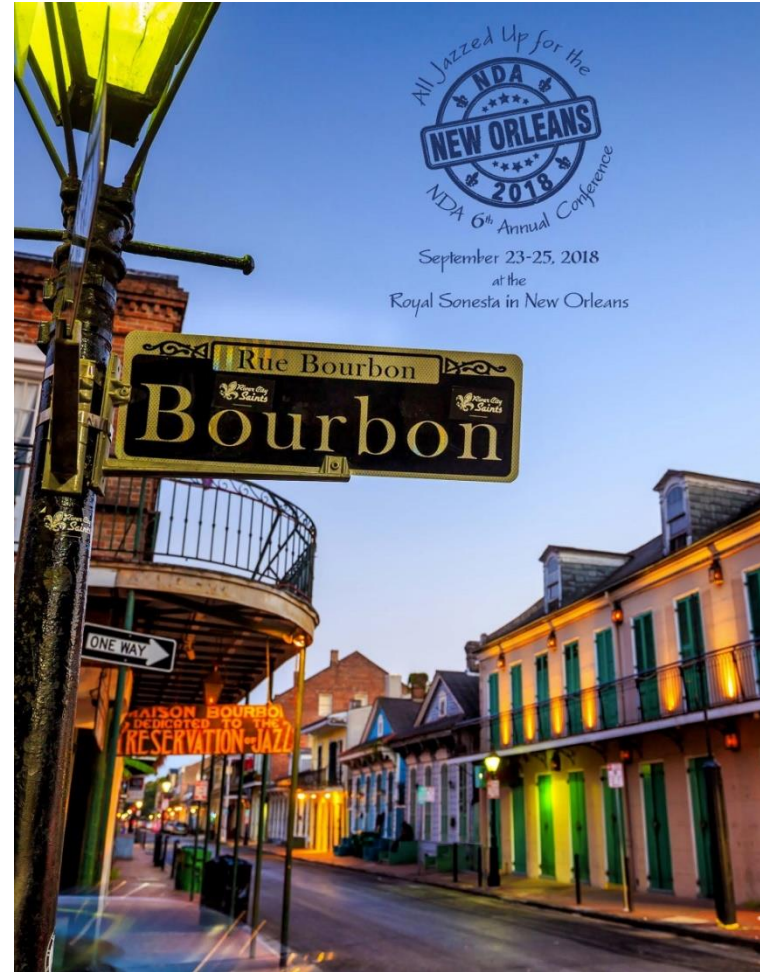

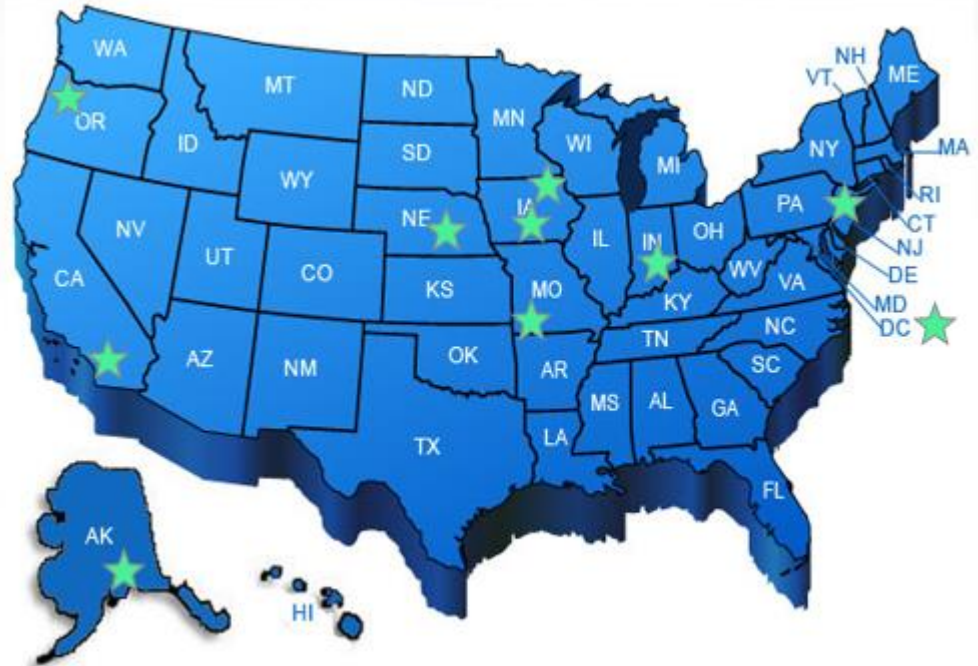

NextGen Implementation Update (August 2018)



- 31 Live Courts
- 12 Courts have planned go live date
- 137 courts signed up for a wave
- Total of 172 courts involved with NextGen
 - 13 Appellate
 - 81 District
 - 78 Bankruptcy

NYSB Conversion Process

Go-Live Date: October 22, 2018

- January 2018 - process begins
- May 2018 - <http://www.nysb.uscourts.gov>
 - Broadcast email to all users regarding conversion/website update
 - Alerted FACER Service Center to prepare for influx of calls
- August 2018 - Broadcast email to all users of Go-Live Date/website update
- September 2018
 - Testing of NextGEN and local modifications
 - Training of staff and the Bar

Login Information



CurrentGen Sign-on

FACER Login

- One ID/password for all courts
- Centrally validated
- Allows read-only access
- One account often shared within a firm

CM/ECF Login (Attorney Filer Account)

- Independent ID/password for each court
- Locally validated
- Rights assigned by issuing court



Login Information



NextGen Central Sign-On

- Single ID/password for each individual
- Eliminates need for separate PACER and Attorney filing IDs
- One ID works for filing in all NextGen courts and PACER in any Current Gen or NextGen court
- IDs should not be shared among users because they include filing permission



Login Information



NextGen Central Sign-On

- Firms can manage PACER billing for multiple accounts by establishing a PACER Administrative Account (FAA)
- Information on Central Sign-On and FAA accounts is available at www.pacer.gov
- The PACER Service Center (PSC) is also available to assist (1-800-676-6856)

NextGen CSO Steps



Step 1

- Obtain your own individual PACER account, if you do not already have one. Register for a new PACER account by clicking here:

- If you already have your own PACER account, then go to Step 2.



NextGen CSO Steps



Step 2

■ If you have your own individual FACER account and it was created prior to August 11, 2014 (also known as Legacy account), you must upgrade your account before you can electronically file in a NextGen court. Please see the learning module below on upgrading your FACER account (a PDF copy has been included for your convenience).

Step 3

- Note your current CM/ECF login and password. This is the login and password you are currently using. If you do not know your password, please contact the court directly.



NextGen CSO Steps



Step 4

- Upon Go-Live (NYSB, October 22, 2018), you must link your upgraded FACER account to your NYSB NextGen CMVECF account. Users will NOT be able to file in NextGen until their CMVECF account is linked to their upgraded individual FACER account.
